

Judging.

Entries will be judged by a small team selected by the chairman of the Harpenden Society and including representatives from both organisations. The winning images will be those that are considered by the judges to have artistic merit and be representative of their obvious association with Harpenden

Additionally

Winning photographs may be used to as part of an image bank the Harpenden Society could use in its future campaigns to illustrate important issues in their newsletter, website and local media. The photographer's name will be credited accordingly.

Conditions

Images should not contain recognisable facial images unless the individual has given their express written permission for it to be used.

A condition of entry is that the Harpenden Society has a royalty free non-exclusive perpetual licence to use the submitted images in all media, but not for profit. All images used would be attributed.

Images must have been taken by the entrant and may be digitally enhanced, using common Photoshop or equivalent processes executed by the entrant but the use of AI and similar technology is prohibited.

Disputes

The decision of the judges is final.

Changes to the completion, including clarification on these terms and conditions, can be made by the chairman of the Harpenden Society.

All references to Harpenden Society shall include any successor body to which it may transfer the whole, or substantially the whole, of its undertaking.
