
Results of Questionnaire

- Over 1300 answers/comments/suggestions


Questionnaire – Who Responded?

Q1. Do you/your clients have complaints about parking?




Q1. Do you/your clients have complaints about parking?

- Both parties struggle many complain
- Customers find it hard to find spaces, other than 30mins
- Frequently a big issue is season ticket holders struggling to park because of school drop-off
- Blanket restrictions off Station Road seem unnecessary and not helpful to anyone

- Lack of spaces and length of time too short
- Not enough parking for retailers
- Rarely come into Harpenden as can't find parking space
- We have a small car park, but clients who can't get in complain about the cost of parking

Does lack of parking places affect your business (e.g. late for appointments)?




Q2 - Does lack of parking places affect your business (e.g. late for appointments)?

- Absolutely many arrive late due to lack of parking
- A constant source of worry when trying to get medical appts.
- Clients confused
- Adds time to the working day
- School buses use disabled bays for children going to sports centre, patients can't use them.
- People rush back to their cars, otherwise they would linger over desserts etc

Q2 - Does lack of parking places affect your business (e.g. late for appointments)?

- Yes need to go early in case of difficulties. this causes me worry as I have a blue badge and cannot walk very far.
- Yes Customers complain all the time about lack of parking
- Yes especially when our car park is used by people not shopping at our store
- Yes have lost a lot of money because of lateness a full service could not be completed
- Yes some people cannot come to pick up their parcels
- Yes we can be. Late opening shop delivery drivers struggle

Q3 - Do you/your clients no longer come for fear of not parking?

- Yes disabled parking too limited
- Yes have lost clients
- Yes on Farmers Market especially
- You have to arrive earlier and earlier to find a space
- Avoid Harpenden at busy times
- Certainly shop less in Harpenden
- I go to St Albans as more parking spaces
- I avoid Harpenden due to lack of space
- I choose my time if possible. Quite a worry for an appointment etc.

Q3 - Do you/your clients no longer come for fear of not parking?

...."I live in Kimpton, have for years, come to Harpenden to catch the train to London & to go to the hairdressers & opticians. I now get the train from WGC as it is cheaper to park there (£5). With parking for the hairdressers & opticians so difficult, I plan to stop coming and find businesses elsewhere- so not only will these lose my custom, but also the local shops which I would have visited at the same time."

Q4 How much would you be prepared to pay p.h. for parking?


- Nominal sum as resident

Q5 - Do you object to cars parking on the pavement?







Q5 - Do you object to cars parking on the pavement?

- Very much so
- The law provides for access to footpaths by sight disadvantaged and wheelchair users
- Not ideal but where else to park?
- Not really, but then I don't have a pushchair or wheelchair
- Risk to pedestrians
- When they park too far on pavement leaving no room for double buggies. Should be ticketable offence
- Often no choice but to use pavements
- No, as long as it is a parking space



Q6 - Do you use the Station car parks - if so what is your experience of them?

- Always full
- Awful
- Can't get in, no spaces after 7:30am
- Expensive if all day
- Would avoid station in the week. Sat parking is better and cheaper
- Not many disabled spaces.
- Yes I have to park 2 miles from the station
- I can never park there as it's full. It is also expensive £10.90 against WGC £5, so I shall no longer be coming to Harpenden for onward travel to London or to shop.

Q7 - If you work locally do you have problems with parking?

- Now cycle due to parking problems
- Lydekker £10.80pd usually has spaces others full
- I pay £80 pm for parking
- Patients block spaces
- Cost of car parks too expensive for a retail wage, so walk
- Part time worker cannot afford parking
- Have private car park or otherwise it would not be worth working
- Anyone who can find a solution is a miracle worker!

Q8 Any Other Comments - Solutions

- Need multi-storey Bowers Way, Station, other ones
- More parking required at station Remember the villages
- Create more parking, especially if we are going to build many more houses! 2 cars per household
- If we want to save our High Street decent parking is a must for customer's cars and delivery vans for local businesses

Q8 Any Other Comments - Ideas

- More enforcement. Machines in town
- Park and ride
- Affordable or free parking to ensure that the town centre is a place where people can enjoy shopping
- Desperately need more disabled parking in service roads adjacent to shops
- Encourage driveway parking
- We need more cheaper town centre car parks
- Could workers in High street get a concession for parking

Q8 Any Other Comments - General

- A days parking is more than 1 hours pay for shop workers
- Future likely to be intolerable due to new housing
- Holiday parking for 2 weeks is anti social
- Live in St. Albans would like to shop in Harpenden, but no parking
- Need to act now
- Reality there is no chance of a space unless 'fight' mode
- Spaces are too small Too many cars for Harpenden not enough car parks
- Why is Lydekker so expensive?
- Since the new school opened, parents seem to do whatever they like

Any Other Comments - Problems

- Car Park operators do not maintain the standard equal to the exorbitant charges
- Parking & Traffic is a nightmare, dreadful, shocking, very bad, too expensive
- Double yellow abused, Amenbury full of vans
- I avoid the town
- I can never find anywhere to park in Harpenden
- Lighting poor for walking to car
- The CPZ scheme has exacerbated the parking problem in Harpenden
- HCC, SADC, HTC are rubbish
